## Important Safety Information

Plan B<sup>®</sup> is used to prevent pregnancy after unprotected sex or contraceptive failure.

**Plan B<sup>®</sup> should not be used if you are already pregnant (because it will not work), if you are allergic to levonorgestrel or any of the ingredients in Plan B<sup>®</sup>, or for regular birth control.**

Menstrual bleeding may be heavier or lighter, earlier or later after taking Plan B<sup>®</sup>. If your period is more than a week late, pregnancy should be considered.

**Plan B<sup>®</sup> does not protect against the AIDS virus (HIV) or other sexually transmitted diseases (STDs).**

Common side effects associated with the use of Plan B<sup>®</sup> included nausea, vomiting, stomach pain, tiredness, diarrhea, dizziness, breast pain, headache, and menstrual changes.

### Important Safety Information

**Plan B<sup>®</sup> does not protect against HIV infection and other sexually transmitted diseases (STDs). You should not take Plan B<sup>®</sup> if you are already pregnant (because it will not work).**

Side effects with Plan B<sup>®</sup> include nausea, abdominal pain, fatigue, headache, menstrual changes, dizziness, breast tenderness, vomiting, and diarrhea. Menstrual bleeding may be heavier or lighter, earlier or later after taking Plan B<sup>®</sup>.

If your period is more than a week late, pregnancy should be considered. Do not take Plan B<sup>®</sup> if you have undiagnosed vaginal bleeding or are allergic to levonorgestrel or any of the ingredients in Plan B<sup>®</sup>. Plan B<sup>®</sup> should not be used as routine birth control.
