Important Safety Information

Plan B[®] is used to prevent pregnancy after unprotected sex or contraceptive failure.

Plan B[®] should not be used if you are already pregnant (because it will not work), if you are allergic to levonorgestrel or any of the ingredients in Plan B[®], or for regular birth control.

Menstrual bleeding may be heavier or lighter, earlier or later after taking Plan B[®]. If your period is more than a week late, pregnancy should be considered.

Plan B[®] does not protect against the AIDS virus (HIV) or other sexually transmitted diseases (STDs).

Common side effects associated with the use of Plan B[®] included nausea, vomiting, stomach pain, tiredness, diarrhea, dizziness, breast pain, headache, and menstrual changes.

Important Safety Information

Plan B[®] does not protect against HIV infection and other sexually transmitted diseases (STDs). You should not take Plan B[®] if you are already pregnant (because it will not work).

Side effects with Plan B[®] include nausea, abdominal pain, fatigue, headache, menstrual changes, dizziness, breast tenderness, vomiting, and diarrhea. Menstrual bleeding may be heavier or lighter, earlier or later after taking Plan B[®].

If your period is more than a week late, pregnancy should be considered. Do not take Plan B[®] if you have undiagnosed vaginal bleeding or are allergic to levonorgestrel or any of the ingredients in Plan B[®]. Plan B[®] should not be used as routine birth control.
